Mudgee District Hockey is supporting a code of conduct that we would like all players and supporters to read and understand. **Signing the registration form indicates that you, and your child (if appropriate) have accepted the code of conduct which follows.**

MUDGEES DISTRICT HOCKEY ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Players:

1. Play fairly within the rules of the game.
2. Act responsibly on and off the field.
3. Attend whenever possible to play as part of a team.
4. Encourage players on all teams. Applaud good hockey and never abuse other people for their mistakes.
5. Respect the decisions of umpires and coaches.

Parents/Guardians and Supporters:

1. Encourage children to do their best and praise them for their efforts. Offer constructive criticism but not abuse.
2. Encourage each person to play within the rules and spirit of the game.
3. Help wherever possible. Ask for assistance if you need it.
4. Ensure that your child attends regularly and develops a "team philosophy".
5. Provide transport or arrange transport for your child when needed.
6. Respect the decisions of umpires and coaches and encourage the players to have this attitude.

Mudgee District Hockey Association Inc. (MDHA) administers and convenes hockey activities in which many players, parents, spectators, convenors, umpires and others participate. MDHA expects all participants in MDHA events, both locally and representative in nature, to take responsibility for their own safety by observing instructions, rules and guidelines, by wearing compulsory safety equipment when applicable and by behaving in a safe and responsible manner towards other participants, officials, property and grounds.

While MDHA takes measures to make the sporting activities as safe as possible for all participants, there is a risk that those involved may be injured and suffer loss (including financial loss) and damage as a result of their participation in these hockey activities, whether travelling, at training or in actual events.

Injury can occur while the participant is engaging in, watching or officiating at a hockey activity, or travelling to and from the event. The injury may result from the participant's actions or the actions of others.

On some occasions, an injury can be serious (such as torn ligaments, dislocations, back injuries, concussion or broken bones). In very rare cases the injury can be life threatening or result in permanent disability. If a participant has a pre-existing injury, participating in a sporting activity could result in an exacerbation of that injury.

Participants could also suffer loss as a result of their personal property being lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed.

By agreeing to participate in this sport, the participant, whether a player; parent; spectator; convenor; umpire or other, accepts all risks and will not hold the MDHA liable for any injury or loss incurred on or off the field. MDHA recommends the wearing of personal protective equipment such as mouth guards and shin pads.
